MOTIF-DESCRIPTION -

In the centre of the city of Kaiserslautern, on the 21st floor of the city hall, Artur Stark from Kaiserslautern has created "21", a lounge with café and bar in a special design. There are two roof terraces on the high-rise building, one with an almost all-round view directly at the restaurant and the other one floor higher and facing west. From the higher terrace, fantastic sunsets over the city can be photographed. Photographs towards the east are particularly suitable for long exposures in the evening, as there are two busy roads there, which produce a very strong surreal effect, e.g. with 30 s exposure time.

Kaiserslautern City Hall, Willy-Brandt-Platz 1, 67655 Kaiserslautern; there is a lift directly at the western side entrance opposite the Burggymnasium (not the main entrance!).








— MAP OF THE — SURROUNDING AREA AND POIS
